
Joe E. Brown: Film Comedian And Baseball Buffoon



As a young boy in the depths of the 1890s depression, Joe E. Brown had a job: making faces at the firemen on passing coal-burning trains so they would throw coal at him. As a child he also worked as a circus acrobat and newsboy. inventiveness and spunk helped his family get through hard times but also fueled his fascination with entertainment, and he built up a repertoire of rubber-faced expressions and funny antics that would make his stage and screen work memorable. Baseball was a favorite pursuit in his life and thus a recurring theme in his films and skits. this biograph--the first on one of the top film comedians of the 1930--the reader learns of Joes challenging childhood and how it prepared him for later screen roles, and how his love of baseball translated into screen successes. His early career in vaudeville is discussed, his work as a Broadway comedian in the Roaring Twenties, his road to movie stardom, and how he parlayed his love of sports into big hits like 1930s Elmer the Great. The year 1935 gets its own chapter; its films are considered the pinnacle of Browns career, including Alibi Ike, Bright Lights and A Midsummer Nights Dream.
