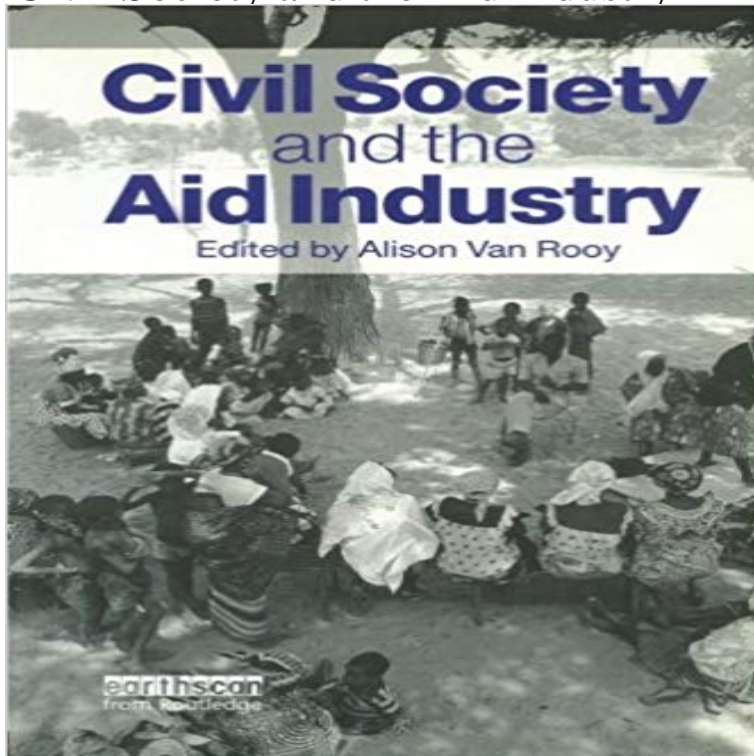


Civil Society and the Aid Industry
