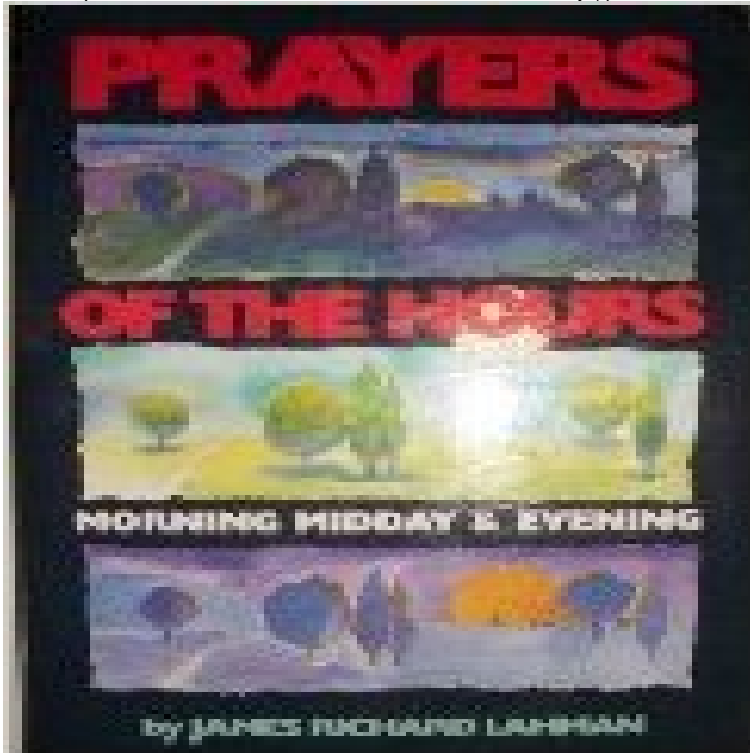


## Prayers of the Hours: Morning, Midday & Evening
