
The Life and Times of a Hoosier Judge



John L. Niblack was one of Indianas most noted judges, holding among other bench assignments Superior and Circuit Court of Marion County judgeships for over twenty years. But before he became a lawyer and judge he was a Pulitzer-Prize- winning journalist for The Indianapolis Times, covering the D.C Stephenson Ku Klux Klan trials in the 1920s. He is listed in the Encyclopedia of Indianapolis and in the Gallery of Famous Hoosiers at the Indiana State Library.
