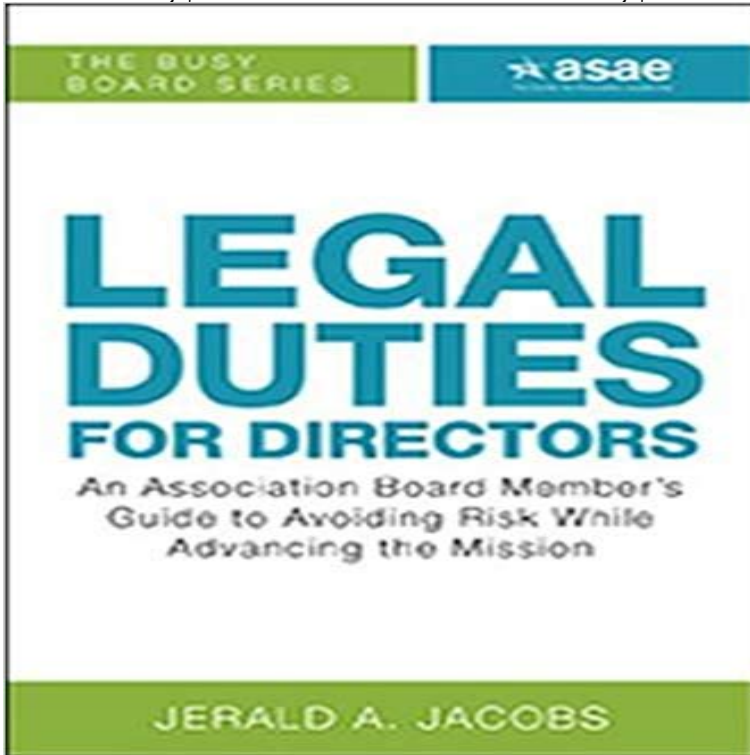


# Legal Duties for Directors: An Association Board Members Guide to Avoiding Risk While Advancing the Mission
