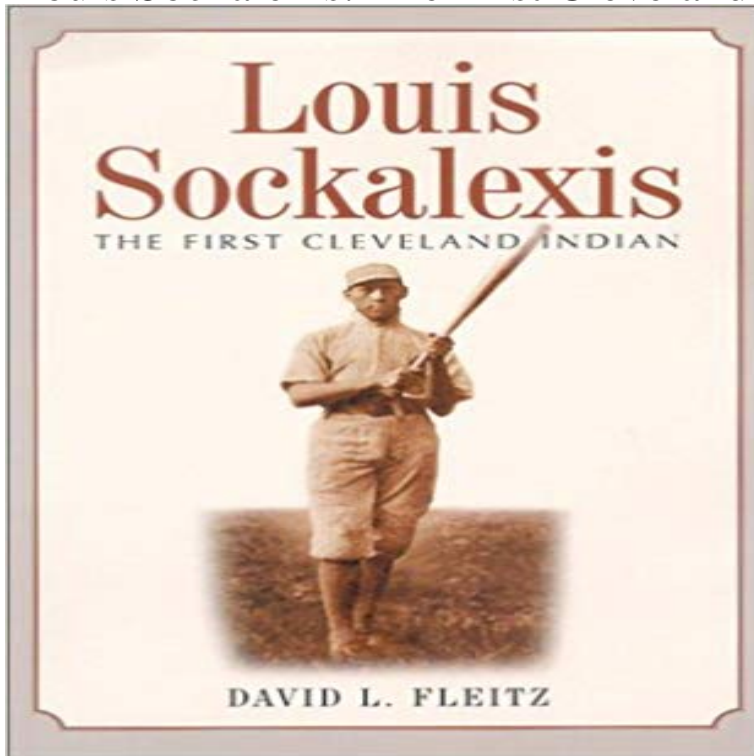


## Louis Sockalexis: The First Cleveland Indian
