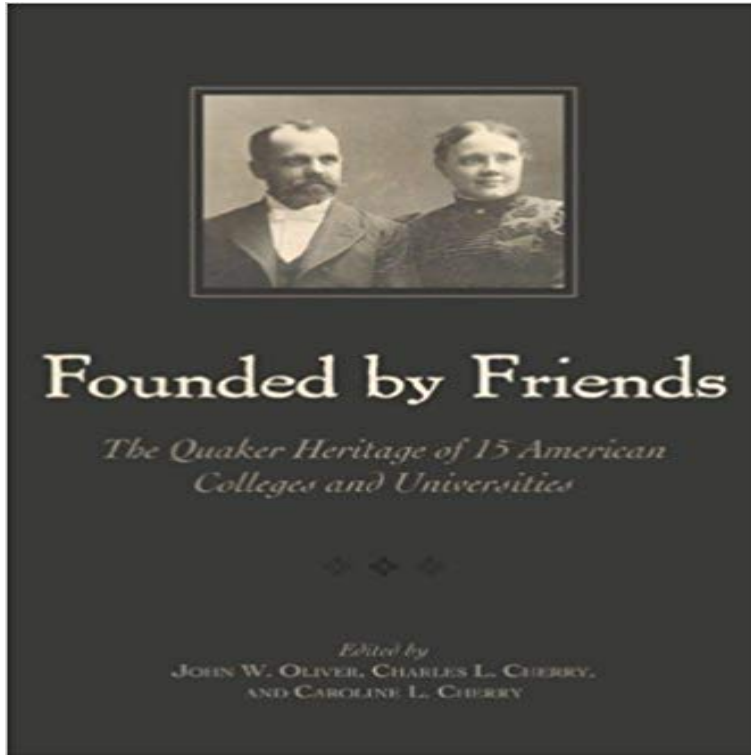


Founded by Friends: The Quaker Heritage of 15 American Colleges and Universities
