
Knowledge Management in the Learning Society: Education and Skills



To function and prosper in the learning society, the management of knowledge is becoming a new and crucial challenge for both private company and public organisations. It is increasingly important for companies and organisations to produce, share and use knowledge on a national and global scale. However, there is an urgent need for analysis of the knowledge economy both at the micro- and level macroeconomic in order understand its characteristics and dynamics, and to identity the most appropriate routes for policy development. Little is known on how sectors and organisations could use knowledge more efficiently benchmark and how to organisations as learning organisations.
