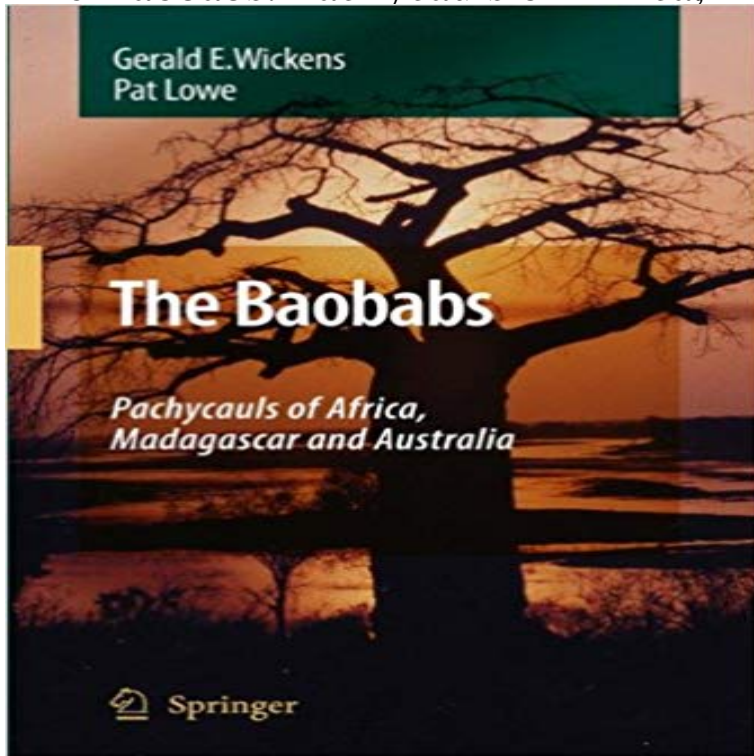


The Baobabs: Pachycauls of Africa, Madagascar and Australia
